TIMELINE

PRE-SURGICAL

- · Consult with surgical specialists at WISE
- 3D Cone Beam Evaluation of Bone with Surgical Specialist- Dr. Walsh.
- Review all medical conditions, coordination with your medical doctor prior to surgery if needed. Please
 provide their contact information to WISE to coordinate care. Medical conditions that need to be
 addressed include Diabetes, Heart Conditions, High Blood Pressure, Joint Replacements, Seizure
 Disorders, Lung, Kidney or Liver Disease, etc....
- Consult with Restorative Dentist to arrange restorative phase. Impressions are needed 3 weeks before surgery.
- Schedule surgery and pay deposit
- Laboratory Tech and Restorative Dentist will work together to design temporary teeth. (This may be more than one appointment)

SURGICAL

- Refer to Pre-Operative Instructions -Do Not Eat, Drink. or Smoke 8 hours prior
- Please bring all medications with you for your surgical appointment (insulin for diabetics)
- For an added prevention against infection please brush your teeth 3-4 times, swish with mouthwash of your choice.
- Be prepared to pay your final payment the day of surgery. We ask that all financial questions be addressed prior to your surgery date. (refer to Initial exam and financial arrangement page)
- Plan to be with us 4-6 hours for the procedure.

POST-SURGICAL

- 2 days post-surgical appointment with Restorative Dentist to check your bite and check on your healing process.
- 2 weeks post-surgical, follow up with Dr. Walsh to evaluate healing process and examine implants.
- 1-2 month follow up with Dr. Walsh to evaluate progress.
- 4-6 month after surgery, follow up with Dr. Walsh for release to schedule with Restorative Dentist

RESTORATIVE PHASE

- Appointment with Restorative Dentist for impressions for Final Bridge design.
- 3-4 weeks later, appointment with Restorative Dentist for Wax try in to finalize for lab work
- 3-4 weeks later, when lab work is complete, schedule placement of bridge with Restorative Dentist
- Regular check ups with Restorative Dentist for hygiene and maintenance with Restorative Dentist

PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

EVERY PATIENT MUST ARRNE AT LEAST 10 MINUTES BEFORE SURGERY TO AVOID RESCHEDULING!!!

- 1. **DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING FOR EIGHT HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR SURGERY!** (Appointment will be rescheduled and a possible charge may occur.)
- 2. Take prescribed medication the morning of surgery with a small amount of water (sips only).
- 3. **NO SMOKING** 12 hours before surgery!
- 4. No drinking alcohol for at least 24 hours before surgery.
- 5. Brush your teeth thoroughly before surgery.
- 6. A RESPONSIBLE ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY THE PATIENT TO THE OFFICE, AND MUST REMAIN IN THE OFFICE DURING THE ENTIRE SURGERY. DRIVE THE PATIENT HOME, AND SUPERVISE THE PATIENT FOR 24 HOURS FOLLOWING SURGERY!
- 7. Wear loose, comfortable clothing and a **SHORT SLEEVED** shirt!
- 8. Remove all makeup before surgery.

- 9. **NAIL POLISH** must be removed before surgery!
- 10. Flu-like, head or chest cold symptoms MUST be reported to the office before surgery.
- 11. Schedule 48-72 hours off work and/or school.
- 12. Do not operate a vehicle, machinery, or engage in any job or school related activity for 24 hours following surgery or your last dose of pain medication.
- 13. <u>CANCELLATIONS MUST BE</u> MADE *AT*<u>LEAST 24 HOURS BEFORE YOUR</u>
